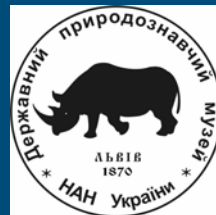

Implemented by Wageningen International (Project organiser and final responsibility) and CERI as the Local Project Implementer.

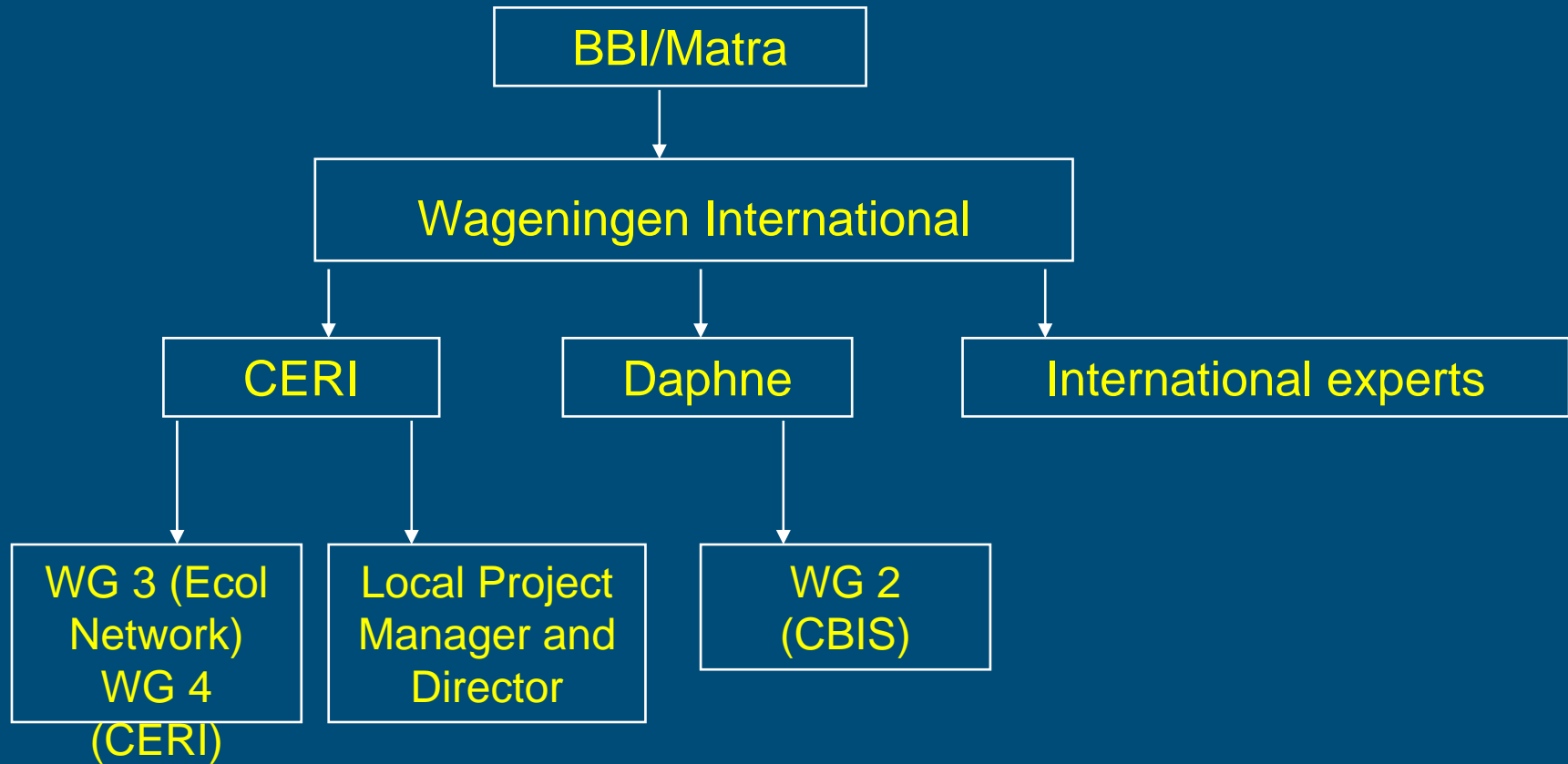
The overall objective of the project

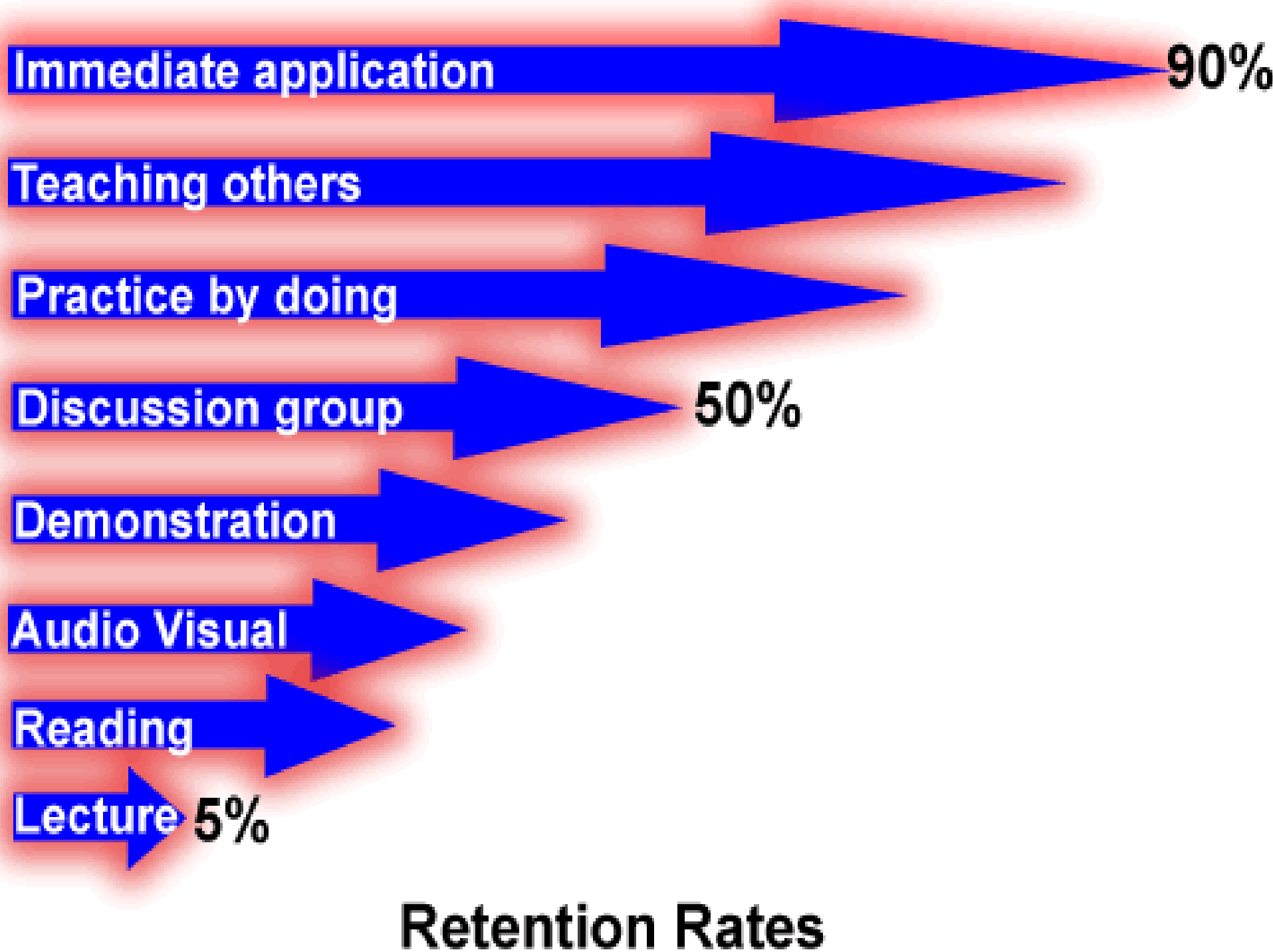
To support the implementation of the Carpathian Convention through the development and implementation of a coherent transboundary ecological network as part of sustainable development of the Carpathians.

Project Objectives

- Establish a Carpathian Biodiversity Information System
 - Develop a Carpathian Ecological Network
 - Increase the capacities of the organisations in Ukraine, Romania and Serbia to design and manage ecological networks and to implement relevant EU and international policies. (PEEN, N-2000, Agriculture, Forestry)
 - Strengthen organisational structure and capacities of the CERI to support the implementation of the Carpathian Convention
